Please submit the completed application and all supporting materials via email to scholarships@cola.org no later than **December 16, 2024.**

The scholarship selection committee will verify all eligibility requirements are met and group applications by degree. A team of volunteer COLA staff members evaluate the letter of recommendation, short answer questions and essay. Scores are compiled for each candidate. The applicants receiving the highest scores in each degree (associate, bachelor and advanced degrees) are awarded the scholarships. Winners will be notified by email on or before **Jan 31**, **2025**.
